SURFACE PREPARATION

Wet a clean cloth thoroughly with Dynacoat Uni Degreaser and degrease/ clean the surface by rubbing steadily.
 Immediately thereafter take a new clean cloth and rub the surface dry.

Note: to avoid condensation always use solvent borne degreasers at temperatures between 16 and 25°C
